

- Care Coordination by a Nurse Care Manager

2022 Model of Care Performance



Here are some of our Model of Care performance measure results for 2022:

- 100% of new members had a health risk assessment within 90 days of enrollment
- 100% had a designated Case Manager within 60 days of enrollment
- 96% of high-risk beneficiaries at least once every week and of the moderate risk every other week seen by a Nurse Practitioner
- 96.5% Interdisciplinary Care Team Involved in creating initial care plan
